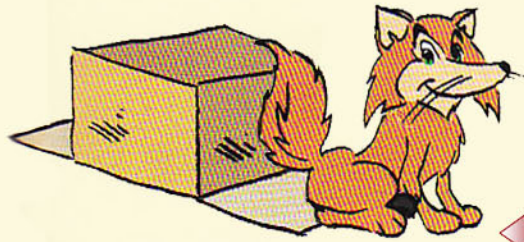


PREPOSITIONS: Pictionary

▶ **REMEMBER:**

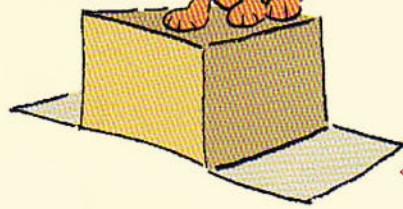
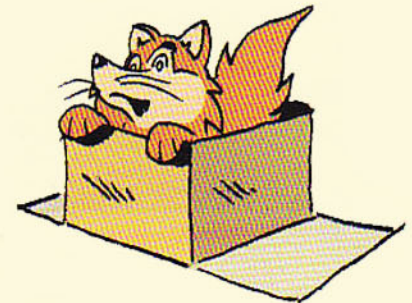
We use prepositions of place to say *where* people, animals or things are.



The fox is **next to** the box.

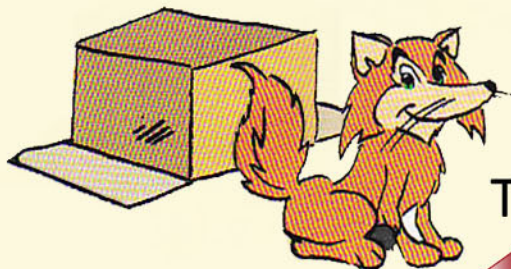


The fox is **in** the box.



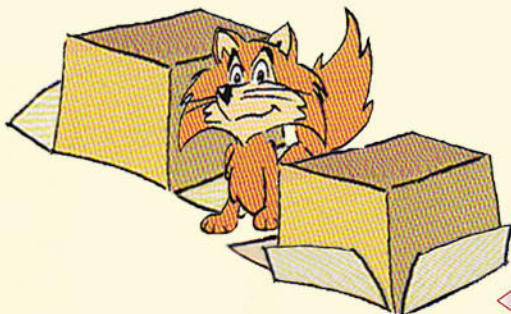
The fox is **on** the box.

The fox is **under** the box.



The fox is **in front of** the box.

The fox is **behind** the box.



The fox is **between** the two boxes.
