<b>Are you a student?</b>	Yes you are	No, you aren't
<b>Is he a student? Is she a student? Is it a table?</b>	Yes, he is Yes, she is Yes, it is	No, he isn't No, she isn't No, it isn't
<b>Are we students?</b>	Yes we are	No, we aren't
<b>Are you students?</b>	Yes you are	No, you aren't
<b>Are they students?</b>	Yes they are	No, they aren't
