Per fare una frase affermativa mettiamo prima la persona, poi il verbo. Guarda l'esempio.

ESEMPIO

I am at home.
You are my friend.
She is my sister.

oppure
oppure
oppure

I'm at home.
You're my friend.
She's my sister.

ATTENZIONE

Possiamo anche fare la forma negativa:

I am not at home.	oppure	I'm not at home.
You are not my friend.	oppure	You aren't my friend.
She is not my sister.	oppure	She isn't my sister.
